PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

VAS on Edgioake Lane – The Council are pleased to confirm the purchase of the new solar powered vehicle activated sign that will be situated just past SE Davis as you drive into Astwood Bank on Edgioake Lane. The Councillors hope that it will act as a deterrent to motorists speeding on this stretch of road.
