Local Council Elections – May 2019

The Local Council Elections will take place on Thursday 2nd May 2019. Nominations for prospective candidates must be hand-delivered to the Returning Officer at Wychavon District Council between 22nd March and 4pm on the 3rd April 2019.

A seminar for candidates will take place on Thursday 28th February at 6:15pm at the Civic Centre, Pershore.

To vote in a local election you must:

- Be registered to vote.
- Be 18 or over on the day of the election (2nd May 2019)
- Be registered at an address in the area you want to vote in
