Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 14th March 2017

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Speeding & Traffic Calming on the Ridgeway -Following the last meeting the Parish Council have had confirmation that a 'SLOW' will be painted on the road at the end of March. A vehicle activated sign has also been ordered and will be sited just before the bend with the intention of slowing traffic as it approaches.

Cookhill Village Hall - Cllr Sumner advised the meeting of the upcoming Skittles evening on 25th March

Asbestolux Building – Following Storm Doris some damage was sustained by an old Asbestolux hut on Parish Council land. Cllr Pinfield advised the meeting that after some investigation he believes the hut to be a Nissan hut. It will need to be removed from the site under semi controlled conditions and it has been offered to Avoncroft Museum at Bromsgrove.

Grants - Grants were awarded to Cookhill Baptist Church, St. Paul's Church & Cookhill Cricket Club.

Skip Hire - The Parish Council will once again be hiring a skip for the use of parishioners and it will be sited on the Village Hall car park on 3rd & 4th of June. Lengthsman – The Parish Council were advised that

the Lengthsman Scheme will continue in 2017/18 with work carried out to keep the Parish tidy.

Parish Paths - Mr Mitchell reported that he has been working his way round the many Parish paths, putting up waymarkers where necessary and reporting footpath signs that require maintenance.

Handmade Fair – Ragley Hall will be hosting Kirstie Allsopp's Handmade Fair from the 12th to 14th May.

Following contact with the organisers the clerk reported that no significant traffic congestion is expected.

Allotments - The Allotment Association have confirmed that there will be one plot available on the popular Cookhill allotments from April. If you are interested please contact the clerk on 07584 687283.

Cookhill Playing Fields - The Chairman reported that the new equipment is being well used. New signage is in the process of being produced.
