Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 13th March 2018.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Recent Snow – The Parish Council expressed their gratitude to members of the SE Davis team for their help in clearing the roads during the recent extreme snowy conditions. Thanks was also passed on to the parishioners and members of the community who came out and helped with the snow clearing, using their own vehicles. The Council asked residents to please remember to keep vehicles clear of the road during bad weather, to enable the gritter and snow ploughs to get through.

Lengthsman – The Lengthsman scheme is set to continue in 2018-19. The Cookhill Parish Lengthsman carried out a wide range of essential maintenance jobs around the Parish during February.

Allotment & Field Rents – The Parish Council agreed to review the rents for the allotments and Parish fields in 2019.

Cookhill Village Hall – The Spring Fair was held in the Village Hall on Saturday 10th March. The Parish Council were in attendance with information on the Community Speed Watch programme and help regarding planning procedures.

VAS on Edgioake Lane – The new vehicle activated sign was due to be installed on Edgioake Lane on 6th March but due to the snow the installation has been postponed until late March.

Rural Crime – Come along to the next Parish Council meeting on the 10th April if you would like to speak to the local policing team.

Severn Trent Water – You will have noticed extensive work to replace water pipes in the parish being carried out along the Evesham Road over the past month. This work is set to move further into the village over the coming weeks. If you have any questions about the planned works, or are worried about potential disruptions, you can contact the clerk, or come along to the next Parish Council meeting on the 8th May when a member of the Severn Trent team will be available to address your concerns.
