Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 9th May 2017.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

AGM of Cookhill Parish Council

Appointment of Chair and Vice Chair of Cookhill Parish Council – The Councillors re-elected Cllr Pinfield as Chair and Cllr Sumner as Vice Chair and they signed their Acceptance of Office. All Councillors were reminded to check their register of interests regularly.

Neighbourhood Watch Reports – The meeting was advised of the attempted theft of some trial bikes from a trailer in Astwood Bank. The trailer had been fitted with a tracking device at an event to enable the thieves to locate the bikes.

Cookhill Playing Fields – The Council agreed to look into replacing one of the baby swings to enable older children to use the swings.

Speeding & Traffic Calming on the Ridgeway – The new VAS has now been installed and will flash up to warn drivers of the approaching bend. The SLOW on the road outside the Nevill Arms is felt to be too far from the bend and is causing confusion.

County Councillor Anthony Hopkins – The Parish Council welcomed newly elected Cllr Hopkins to the meeting and he advised the Council of a Rural Hustings to be held in Inkberrow on 22nd May, giving constituents a chance to raise issues with the Parliamentary candidates before the General Election.

Parish Paths – Mr Mitchell has now reported all damaged and missing road signs to the Highways Department and replaced missing finger posts and waymarkers. He is working on clearing any blocked paths and stiles.
