Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 13th June 2017.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Neighbourhood Watch Reports – Parishioners received a postal invite to join a new social networking site called Nextdoor.Cookhill in the last week. The site asks you to connect with your neighbours via the site. Unfortunately some Parishioners had signed up thinking that the site was run by the Parish Council **but this is not the case**. If you have signed up to this website please note that it is not endorsed, or run, by the Parish Council or Neighbourhood Watch.

Staying safe online – *It is important to protect your personal information whilst using the internet. The PC advise, that you do NOT give personal information to any organisation without researching it and until you are certain of their credentials.*

New VAS – Now installed on the Ridgeway, just after the Nevill Arms and working well.

Cookhill Allotments – No damage was reported after the recent storms and the plots look neat and tidy. New regulations regarding the use of certain professional weed killers is now in force.

Skip Hire – It was reported that the hire of a skip for residents had caused the Village Hall a number of problems, including considerable mess and the disposal of asbestos and building materials! The PC agreed that they would not be providing this service in the future.

Playing Field Update – The Parish Council will be investigating replacing the damaged baby swing with a larger one.
