PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Community Speed Watch

Severn Trent Water - Works continue through the village to replace the water main and the A441, Evesham Road remains closed from Cookhill Priory through to Church Lane.

Whilst everything is being done to minimise disruption it is important for motorists to use the diversions where possible. The diversion takes you down Salt Way, towards Droitwich or Hangingswell Lane for Alcester.

Verges – Highways have confirmed that they do not give permission for stones/rocks to be placed on a highway verge as these cannot be seen in the dark and can damage passing vehicles if struck. If the verge is privately owned landowners must ensure anything placed on the verge is safe or else they may be liable to prosecution.

Police & Neighbourhood Watch - Residents were reminded to keep sheds and outbuildings secured.
