Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 10th July 2018.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Severn Trent Water – The works along the Evesham Road are nearing completion. Residents in Church Lane have found the diversion signage to be very confusing for HGVs with several larger vehicles using the lane to turn around and then becoming stuck. The signage issue was reported to Severn Trent and also the Highways department.

Community Speed Watch

The Parish Council are looking for more volunteers to carry out the Community Speed Watch sessions on Edgioake Lane. There is a possibility that these sessions may be rolled out to other locations.

Police & Neighbourhood Watch – Following forced entry to residential outbuildings and some sheds on the allotment site, residents were reminded to keep sheds and outbuildings secured and to report suspicious activity to the Police on 101.

Lengthsman & Parish Paths Warden – The Parish Council thanked the Lengthsman and the Paths Warden for keeping the footpaths & verges clear.

GDPR – New regulations in force from 25th May

Verges

Residents are reminded that Highways **do not** give permission for stones/rocks, or other solid items, to be placed on the highway verge, as these cannot be seen in the dark and can cause damage to passing vehicles if struck. If the land is privately owned then Highways advise that the land owner must ensure anything placed on the verge is safe. Land owners who place items that cause an obstruction may be liable to prosecution.

Proposal: Proposed open canopy to three sides of existing storage building, and change of use to allow storage of machinery and equipment.

Proposal: Extension to form enlarged kitchen and bedroom above.
