Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 11th September 2018

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Cookhill Allotments – Update – Following two incidents of theft from sheds on the allotments during the early part of the year all tenants were advised not to keep expensive machinery on-site. The Parish Council have agreed to fund the purchase of a second secure steel storage container for the site to keep more expensive equipment safe.

The allotment association AGM will take place on Monday 24th September at the Nevill Arms from 5pm. Currently, all 34 plots are occupied, with one expected to become available in the autumn.
