#### PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

<u>Potholes on Brandheath Lane</u> – Following a visit from the Highways safety officer the potholes in Brandheath Lane have been filled.

# Police & Neighbourhood Watch Reports -

Scam Phone Calls – Reports of bogus Police phone calls where fraudsters pretend to be Police Officers in order to steal bank details, including card numbers and sort codes and PINs. No Police force would ever

ask for bank details over the phone and no information of a sensitive nature should be divulged over the phone.

Bogus Emails about unclaimed parcels – Emails are received stating that a parcel of great value has been received but that the recipient must click on the link to activate the delivery. Never click on a link or download anything in an email you believe to be suspicious. Always delete.
