PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

New Homes Bonus – Cookhill Village Hall have submitted an application to the Parish Council for assistance with their project to refurbish the kitchen & bar area, along with the urgent replacement of the boiler. The PC agreed to a grant (following receipt of 3 quotes), to be used for the boiler replacement and would like to apply for the £6,262 available via New Homes Bonus funding from WDC to be used towards the refurbishment.
