PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

<u>Cookhill Allotment Update</u> – There is currently 1 plot available at the popular Cookhill Allotments site. Please contact the clerk on 07584 687 283 or Mr David Claydon, the Allotment Association Chairman, on 01527 894317 for more information.

<u>Lengthsman Update</u> – Work continues to clear gulleys throughout the parish and blocked drains have been reported to County. The Playing Field hedge has been trimmed and ivy removed. More daffodils will be planted around the Parish before the end of the month.

Flooding & Ditches – Residents with land bordering lanes in the parish will be asked to check and maintain the ditches to avoid flooding.

<u>Village Gateways</u> – It was proposed that installing village gateways on the Salt Way and Edgioake Lane may help to lower the speed of traffic. The Chair and the Clerk are meeting with the Highways Liaison Officer to discuss locations.

Proposal: Construction of outdoor riding arena and replacement stable block for private equestrian use. **Consultation period ended on 30**th **September, the Parish Council recommended approval.**

Wychavon Planning Authority Decisions:

W/19/01665/FUL 7 The Ridgeway, Astwood Bank, Redditch, B96 6LS *Proposal:* Providing a retaining wall to allow for the creation of a usable flat level garden which is currently unusable due to the severity of the landscape gradients. Utilise the wall face as the rear structure for the current / existing greenhouse / bird aviary refurbishment. *Decision:* Approved 03/10/19
