Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 14th November 2017.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Road Traffic Accidents – Two major incidents were reported on Cookhill roads in the last month. One at the bottom of Edgioake Lane and the second by the Nevill Arms. Cllr Davis reiterated that motorists must come to a full stop at the bottom of Edgioake Lane before proceeding. Most of the accidents occurring here are due to collisions as people overtake.

VAS on Edgioake Lane - County Cllr Anthony Hopkins assured the Council that he is taking road safety extremely seriously around the Parish and surrounding villages. He confirmed that a site for a new vehicle activated sign has now been agreed, for Edgioake Lane, by the Highways Department. The Parish Council wish to extend their thanks to Cllr Hopkins for his tireless efforts in getting the installation agreed.

Community Speed Watch – Training for the Community Speed Watch will be taking place soon. *If you would be interested in volunteering to take part in the scheme on Edgioake Lane please contact the clerk on 07584 687283 or info@cookhillparishcouncil.com.*

Noticeboards & Waste Bins – The new noticeboard has now been installed outside Ridgeway Meadows and the SE Davis noticeboard replaced. The dog waste bin on Oak Tree Lane has also been moved to a more accessible location at the crossroads. A new waste bin has been agreed for Ridgeway Meadows.

Footpaths & Lengthsman – The Parish Paths Warden reported that some of the footpaths will need strimming & finger posts are on their way. The Lengthsman continues to carry out essential maintenance work around the Parish.

Cookhill Village Hall – The next event scheduled for the Village Hall is the ever popular Skittles Night on 9th December.

There will also be the annual Mulled Wine Evening on Sunday 17th December – a free evening for anyone who supports the Village Hall.
