Summary from Cookhill Parish Council Meeting held
Tuesday 12th November 2019

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Signage on the Salt Way – County Cllr Anthony Hopkins reported that the signs missing at the top of the Salt Way and at the Edgioake crossroads have met with further delays at the ordering stage but will be installed as soon as possible.

Village Gateways – Councillors approved the purchase of 3 sets of village gateways to be sited on the Salt Way and Edgioake Lane. The Parish Council would like to thank Cllr Hopkins & Worcester Highways Locally Determined Fund and, also the PCC's Local Policing & Community Ambassador's Fund (Safer Roads) Grant Scheme for the funding.

Ditches and Gullies – Following the recent heavy rain drains and ditches are being monitored, with local landowners being asked to maintain the ditches on their properties.

Flooding – All areas of the village that are subject to flooding are being monitored, with blocked drains being reported to Highways for urgent attention.

Parish Paths & Lengthsman – The footpath from the Village Hall to the Nevill is currently being sided out by the Lengthsman. Some missing finger posts have been reported to County for attention and the damaged sign at Oak Tree Lane is to be replaced.

Cookhill Allotment Update – There is currently 1 plot available at the popular Cookhill Allotments site.
