PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

<u>Parish Council Gritter</u> – The Parish Council gritter has been out in the village during the bad weather. The gritting is carried out by volunteer Councillors and although every care is taken to ensure the safety of the roads, Councillors ask that every care and attention is taken when driving around the Parish.

<u>VAS on Edgioake Lane</u> – A new post will need to be installed on Edgioake Lane in order for the relevant solar powered sign to be accommodated. The purchase of the sign was agreed by the Council and will hopefully be in place by February 2018.

<u>Community Speed Watch</u> – As the Council is advancing up the training list it has been agreed that Cookhill can share the equipment currently being used by Inkberrow Parish Council.

POLICE & NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH REPORTS

<u>Planning:</u> the Parish Council has asked Wychavon District Council (WDC) to send notification to us of all planning applications that fall within the parish boundary, these are then discussed at a parish council meeting and the ensuing comments are submitted to WDC.
