PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Cookhill Allotment Update – There is currently 1 plot available at the popular Cookhill Allotments site. *Please contact the clerk on 07584 687 283 or Mr David Claydon, the Allotment Association Chairman, on 01527 894317 for more information.*

Lengthsman & Parish Paths Update – Essential drain and ditch work has been carried out throughout the Parish to ensure roads are kept clear of water.

Edgioake Lane – The flooding on Edgioake Lane is being monitored with signs being placed to warn drivers of potential risk. SE Davis will be carrying out further work to the ditches on the lane in mid December.

Gritter – The new Parish Council gritter will be collected and prepared for use. It was approved that the old gritter will be sold on to recoup costs.

Signage on the Salt Way – A new company has been sought to produce the missing signage.

Drone sitings – Following the siting of an unauthorised drone over the Village Hall in November there have been further siting over properties in Dogbut Lane. Residents are asked to report any suspicious activity on the Police 101 non-emergency number.
