PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES from TUESDAY 10TH MAY 2016

1. Councillors signed their acceptance of office and it was proposed that Cllr Bob Pinfield continue as Chairman, with Cllr Anne Sumner continuing as Vice Chairman.
2. It was reported to the Parish Council about an unexplained explosion involving a post box in Inkberrow and the Parish Council resolved to find out if the proper authorities were taking the matter seriously.
3. The Community Litter Pick held over the Bank Holiday was a success with several parishioners taking part. The Council now hold a permanent Litter Pick kit and are intending to make the picks a regular event, with several people offering to take part.
4. The Council has received a letter from a parishioner reporting a serious speeding issue on the Salt Way. The Clerk reported that she had written to the companies mentioned in the letter and the parishioner would be kept up to date.
5. Drainage and pothole issues continue to be monitored and reported to the County Council with the Lengthsman carrying out work throughout the Parish under the Lengthsman Scheme.
6. Cookhill Village Hall will be holding a Skittles Night on Saturday 28th May at a cost of £6.50 including supper! Contact the Village Hall for more information!

7. It was confirmed that the annual skip would be available to parishioners, in Cookhill Village Hall car park, on the weekend of the 3rd & 4th September, giving everyone a chance to get rid of any unwanted items before the autumn begins in earnest!

Planning: the Parish Council has asked Wychavon District Council (WDC) to send notification to us of all planning applications that fall within the parish boundary, these are then discussed at a parish council meeting and the ensuing comments are submitted to WDC. Comment: Following a site visit by two Parish Councillors it was proposed that the application be **refused** on the grounds that there is not sufficient detail included in the submitted proposal and it is lacking in important information regarding windows and the location of the relevant utilities, for example sewerage.
