Proposal: Lawful Development Certificate (existing) for replacement dwelling commenced but not completed under planning permission (W/06/0142/PN)

Comment: The original planning application of 2007 was passed but various parts of the land have been sold since then. It was also noted that the property falls within green belt land and is not within an established development area. Therefore the Parish Council recommended refusal.

W/15/02611/**PP Location:** 25, The Ridgeway, Astwood Bank, Redditch B96 6LS **Proposal:** Erection of a 2 storey detached single dwelling and alteration to access.

Comment: The council recommended approval providing the plans from the

original passed application were maintained.

The Parish Council would like to remind residents, that although this is a rare occurrence, it is their duty to carry out regular checks and servicing on their oil tanks (especially in the warmer weather following frosts); to get any repairs dealt with immediately, reporting the issue to the relevant agency; and to keep their household insurance up to date to cover their legal responsibilities following leaks.
