Summary from Cookhill Parish Council meeting held Tuesday 16th August 2016

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

1. It was reported that a break-in had occurred in the Parish with a quad bike and some alcohol reported stolen from an outbuilding. The Council expressed an interest in purchasing some Smart Water from Wychavon, for use in the Parish, in a bid to deter crime.
If Parishioners are interested in purchasing some for their properties they are asked to contact the Clerk on 07584 687283.
2. The Lengthsman continues to carry out vital maintenance to footpaths and verges around the Parish, as requested by the Council.
Unfortunately, he has reported a large amount of dog mess along the footpath from Chamberlain Lane to Oak Tree Lane, which is making the job not only very difficult but also extremely unpleasant. In light of this the Council have agreed to put up new signs along this path and will monitor the situation closely.
3. The funding for the new children's play equipment has finally been agreed and it will be ordered for installation as soon as possible! Watch this space for details.
4. The Village Hall have hosted another successful Skittles Night, with a great turn out. This event will be a regular fixture so if you fancy joining in with the fun keep a look out for the next date.
