**PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:** 

- Allotments At the Land Meeting the Allotment Association Chairman reported that all the 36 plots are now in use with two new tenants signed up. They have had a productive and interesting year with a few pest and first aid issues that were quickly dealt with and recorded in the Accident Book. The Allotment Association said that they were very grateful to all the volunteers on site who assist with the general upkeep and maintenance. Their AGM will be held in the Why Not Bar on 26<sup>th</sup> September.
- Ridgeway Meadows The Parish Council have now resolved the issue regarding the boundary hedge at the new Ridgeway Meadows development and a replacement hedge will be planted in October. This will be maintained in perpetuity by the Parish Council.
- Verges Parishioners were reminded that putting anything on the verges that causes an obstruction can be dangerous. It is an offence to block, obstruct or damage road verges. This includes rocks & posts.
- Cookhill Playing Fields The new equipment for the Playing Fields has been ordered and is expected to be delivered and installed towards the end of October. Unfortunately, the table tennis table has been reported as broken, so the Parish Council agreed the purchase of a replacement to complete the playground refurbishment.
- Cookhill Village Hall The popular Skittles evenings will be taking place on 24<sup>th</sup> September & 22<sup>nd</sup> October.
