20.080. Progress Reports

a) County Cllr Anthony Hopkins:

- COVID19 The County Council have a published a plan detailing what procedures are in place should there be a
 localised outbreak in the County. The area would be locked down immediately. Local mobile testing units would
 travel to the location in question to avoid infected people traveling across the county.
- Libraries & Household Recycling Centres Libraries and tips across the county have started to reopen.
- Here2Help There is a dedicated page on the WCC website for anyone looking for assistance regarding COVID19. There is also a link to Here2Help Business.
- Highways The Highways Department are still working to catch up following Lockdown easing.
- Edgioake Crossroads A budget of £60,000 has been allocated to alleviate the accident issues at the Edgioake Crossroad with the Salt Way. Further information to follow.
- Road surface on Lower Cladswell To be reported following recent resurfacing works as it is not fit for purpose.
- b) District Councillor Steel: Vic Allison is the new Managing Director at Wychavon.
- c) District Councillor David Wilkinson: Apologies
- d) Chairman Cllr Pinfield: Dog waste bins are being well used around the Parish.
- e) The Clerk provided an update on the following: Sandholes application to the Land Registry is moving on slowly.
- f) Parish Paths Warden: Apologies
- g) Cookhill Village Hall: The Hall is planning to reopen in September, but only to clubs and groups. Only the main hall will be hired out, with the conference room being used for storing essential PPE. The Hall will not be hired for private functions yet.
- h) Lengthsman Scheme: The Lengthsman has been working hard to clear footpaths around the parish as instructed.
- i) Playing Fields: Following the opening on the 1st August the fields are being well used. The hand sanitiser station has been installed along with posters reminding users to follow the guidelines. The equipment is deep cleaned twice a month.
- j) Affordable Housing Ridgeway Meadows: Residents parking on the pavements will be ticketed.
- k) Cookhill Allotments:
 - 1 vacant plot with 3 people on the waiting list. Plot 38 will need some further work before it is ready to for a new tenant.
 - Social distancing is continuing on site with committee members assisting on plots and filling water butts to avoid items being cross contaminated.
 - Weed killing is required at the site. The Lengthsman will be contacted to carry out the work.
 - There is a problem with rabbits at the site, work will be carried out to repair the perimeter fencing where they may be getting in. Gates to the site must be kept closed.

20.081. Councillor Training

It was agreed that Councillors refresh their knowledge by attending the virtual Councillor training organised by CALC. Training to deal with members of the public who become abusive.

20.082. Reopening of Cookhill Village Hall / Parish Council Meetings 2020/2021

- Cleaning The Village Hall will carry out a deep clean once a week. It will be the responsibility of hirers to clean touch
 points and surfaces before, and after, use. Hirers will be given an extra half an hour before and after their allotted time.
- Hall Hire There are no plans to increase the hire charge at this stage.
- PC Meetings The Parish Council will continue to meet virtually until 2021, as advised by NALC.
