Planning: the Parish Council has asked Wychavon District Council (WDC) to send notification to us of all planning applications that fall within the parish boundary, these are then discussed at a parish council meeting and the ensuing comments are submitted to WDC. All these applications and comments can be seen online via www.wychavon.gov.uk

The following applications were considered for comment:

W/21/01249/HP Thatch Hollow, 30 Oak Tree Lane, Cookhill, Alcester, B49 5LH

Proposed: Single storey ensuite, single storey porch and new roof to existing workshop

Consultation ended on 30th June, the Parish Council recommended APPROVAL.

W/21/01417/HP 24 Wood Lane, New End, Astwood Bank, B96 6NW

Proposed: Single storey side extension and single storey rear extension with first floor

balcony. **Decision:** The Parish Council recommended that the application be REFUSED. All in favour.

W/21/01280/FUL 30 Wood Lane, New End, Astwood Bank, B96 6NW

Proposed: Material change of use of partly residential (C4 use) and agricultural land for the operating of a dog walking business (Sui Generis)

Decision: The Parish Council recommended that the application be APPROVED. 3 for & 2 abstentions.
