



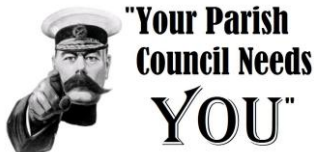

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Government Guidelines regarding remote Parish Council Meetings

The Parish Council have been advised to limit the amount of people at meetings. There is currently no legislation in place for remote meetings to take place. The Parish Council had agreed to hold their pre-budget meeting remotely as it would have been closed to the public anyway. Notes were taken by the clerk but no decisions were made. The budget will be officially approved in January 2022.

Cookhill Allotments

There are currently no vacant plots with two becoming available in the New Year, with one person on the waiting list.

Despite the heavy winds and rains from storms Arwen and Barra, the site escaped any major damage. There is still quite a lot of surface water on some plots. The new drainage system seems to be working well with water draining off the site into the ditch.

Perimeter Fencing is secure but is showing signs of rot and warping in places. Some sections will require replacing / repair over the next two years.

Budget & Precept

The Parish Council discussed the Budget & Precept for 2022/2023. The final figures will be proposed and agreed by the Council at the next 'in-person' meeting in January.

Local Piper

The Parish Council are investigating rewilding part of their land and creating a new avenue of trees and a wildflower meadow. This area will be open for public access.

Lengthsman / Parish Paths

The Lengthsman has been carrying out essential work to clear drains, ditches and gullies around the Parish. All public footpaths around the perimeter fence to the Allotments are clear but starting to get muddy in places. It would help over winter to have some hard core around the metal gate leading to the fields. All hedges have now been trimmed.

Planning: *the Parish Council has asked Wychavon District Council (WDC) to send notification to us of all planning applications that fall within the parish boundary, these are then discussed at a parish council meeting and the ensuing comments are submitted to WDC.
