## Annual Parish Meeting - Tuesday 12th April 2022

The Annual Parish Meeting will take place prior to the next Parish Council meeting on Tuesday 12<sup>th</sup> April at 7pm. Why not come along and meet the Parish Council.

## Plant a Tree for the Jubilee

The free trees, provided by the I Dig Trees initiative, will arrive on 17<sup>th</sup> March. Volunteers from the Cookhill Allotments and some councillors will plant them on 'Planting Day' – Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> March.

#### **Cookhill Allotments**

Thankfully, the site didn't suffer too badly during the February storms. The damaged fence repairs were approved to make the site secure.

The Committee have welcomed four new tenants to the site. There is now one vacant plot.

### Lengthsman / Parish Paths

Following Storm Eunice the Lengthsman cleared several ditches of storm waste. The missing footpath sign on Edgioake Lane has been replaced and the damaged sign on Brandheath Lane, and gate and post at Botany Bay, have been reported for repair.

## **Community Speed Watch**

Training has been booked for early April so that the Speed Watch Team can get back out.

#### **Garages at Cladswell Close**

Rooftop Housing have been out to survey the site. They will be performing a structural survey but it is not thought that the garages will be renovated at this time.

## Cookhill Village Hall

The Village Hall is looking at becoming more eco-friendly in light of energy price increases. They would like to look at solar panels and the possibility of a wind turbine. Due to dwindling numbers some clubs will not continue at the hall. The Computer Club & Internet Café is looking to restart in person after Easter, provided it is safe to do so. The committee are still looking for volunteers to join them, to help with events and the day to day running of the hall.
