PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

Cookhill Village Hall

Following the very successful visit from the Aber Valley Male Voice Choir on 2nd July, the Village Hall would like to thank the choir for such a wonderful performance, SE Davis for their generous sponsoring of the event and also A.P Meats in Alcester for the excellent food. Thank you to everyone who supported the event. The choir will return in 2023!

20's Plenty for Worcestershire Campaign

Cookhill Parish Council supports the campaign to normalise 20mph where people live, shop, work, learn and play. The proposal is to lower the speed limit in areas where the limit is currently set at 30mph.

The local Highway Authority sets local speed limits, erects signs and changes road features via a Traffic Regulation Order. But demonstrating widespread local community support is **critical** to implementing 20mph across the county. We would love to hear your thoughts on these proposals.

Lengthsman / Parish Paths

The Lengthsman has been maintaining the gullies around the Parish and the Parish Paths Warden has been keeping footpaths free from long grass. The new pedestrian gate at Botany Bay will be installed soon.

Planters

Platinum Meadows

The grass at the newly named Platinum Meadows has kindly been cut for the Parish Council by a resident who lives close to the site. He has done a very good job and will begin to cut pathways into the meadow when it has had its final cut. The Parish Council have received some very favourable reports, via the Allotment Association, from walkers who have commented that the site has been enhanced by the tree planting and the maintained path. The Parish Council intend to plant a small orchard in the centre of the meadow and will install a bench for general use. Offers of assistance with further tree planting has been received.

Cookhill Allotments / Parish Council Fields

Drainage Work – The drainage works will continue at the Allotment site towards the end of July. Volunteers from the Allotments mulched the new trees at Platinum Meadows, this went down just in time to keep the soil moist during the current hot spell. The Parish Council wish to thank David and the volunteers for their assistance.
