PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES:

20's Plenty for Worcestershire Campaign

Cookhill Parish Council supports the campaign to normalise 20mph where people live, shop, work, learn and play. The proposal is to lower the speed limit in areas where the limit is currently set at 30mph.

The local Highway Authority sets local speed limits, erects signs and changes road features via a Traffic Regulation Order. But demonstrating widespread local community support is **critical** to implementing 20mph across the county.

Mr Hughes has kindly offered to sponsor the purchase and planting of 4,000 crocus bulbs in conjunction with the Rotary Club. The bulbs will come from Holland and the monies raised will be going to a programme to eradicate Polio across the world. Children from the Ridgeway School will help to plant the bulbs.
