### **Cookhill Allotments / Parish Council Fields**

- Plots & Tenants There are now 38 plots on site due to the dividing of several larger plots. 3 are currently vacant. Parishioners interested in these have been contacted.
- Most tenants are doing well with their plots. Tenants with untidy plots have been reminded to cultivate them to an acceptable standard. The Allotment Association have requested a Parish Council inspection in the next couple of weeks.
- Dogs on site All tenants have been reminded of the rules regarding dogs on site. Whilst a dog
  friendly site, tenants must keep dogs on a lead and clean up after them.
- Footpaths & Internal Grass Track The grass tracks and public footpaths around the site have been
  mown by a tenant volunteer. This tenant has also taken on the task of looking after the ride-on mower
  and is doing a great job.

#### **Platinum Meadows**

- There has been a complaint about antisocial behaviour, and several complaints about dog waste not
  collected, at the meadow. This matter has been reported to the PCSO. A letter will be sent to all the
  residents in Ridgeway Meadows to remind them that dogs must be kept under control, with collars
  and name tags, and dog waste must be collected and binned.
- The grass on the meadow has been let to grow around the paths and won't be cut until later this year.
   Many of the saplings are showing good signs of growth but some of them may need replacing towards the end of the year. The new fruit trees are doing very well. The meadow is being well used, not just by dog walkers, but by families with young children as a quiet recreational area.

#### **Footpaths**

Following reports of several overgrown footpaths around the village the Parish Paths Warden has strimmed back overgrown vegetation to enable walkers to carry on enjoying the many walks around Cookhill and has reported any damaged gates to the PROW Team at WCC.

Walkers are reminded to keep to the official footpaths when out walking and not to stray onto private land. Dogs should be kept under control at all times.
