Platinum Meadows

- Maintenance The long grass in the meadow has now been cut. Approximately 48 trees have been identified as possibly needing replacement in the spring. One of the new apple trees is also showing signs of distress and will be monitored. The hedges will be cut in September as usual.
- Signage It was agreed that appropriate signage be installed at Platinum Meadows. This cannot take place until confirmation is received from the Land Registry, this is still pending.

Footpaths

- The damaged gate, reported to the Public Rights of Way Team has now been assessed and will be replaced by a WCC contractor. The Landowner has been consulted.
- Walkers are reminded to keep to the official footpaths when out walking and not to stray onto private land. Dogs should be kept under control at all times.
