#### **Cookhill Allotments / Parish Council Fields**

- Plots & Tenants There are currently 3 vacant plots, with one person on the Waiting List.
- Extensive rain onsite has meant that some tenants have been unable to access their plots and the grass on the internal tracks is longer than usual and muddy. Tenants are encouraged to still attend to their plots over winter, where the conditions allow.
- Water The taps have been made ready for winter & an underground stop tap installed.

# **Platinum Meadows**

- Wychavon District Council Chairman, Cllr Robert Raphael, visited Platinum Meadows on Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October to see the work carried out by the Parish Council, as part of his endeavour to visit all the parishes in Wychavon as part of his 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary tour. He was shown the new meadow, including the trees planted by the Parish Council and volunteers from Cookhill Parish Allotment Association. He also met with the children from the Ridgeway school who visited the site in November 2022 to plant 4,000 crocus bulbs spelling out the words ELIZABETH II in honour of the Platinum Jubilee and to commemorate the late Queen.
- Daffodils & Trees The Lengthsman has planted daffodil bulbs along the footpath leading from the Ridgeway to Botany Bay. Some of the saplings will need to be replaced in the spring.

Damaged supports to the footbridge on the footpath from the Salt Way alongside Brandheath
Cottage have been reported to the Public Rights of Way Team at Worcestershire County
Council and they will be repaired by a contractor as soon as possible.

# Fancy being a Parish Tree Warden?

Tree Wardens are local tree champions who plant, look after and stand up for the trees in their patch. Whether you want to get your hands in the earth and plant trees, raise awareness about trees in your local community, or simply be the eyes, ears and voice for the trees down your street or in your parish, then you may have what it takes to be a Tree Warden. The Tree Warden scheme has been run by The Tree Council since 1990 and is supported locally by Worcestershire County Council's countryside service. It is a voluntary role and further details are available on the Tree Council's web site on the Tree Warden page. W/23/02192/HP The Cowshed, Linsey Farm, Cladswell Lane, Cookhill, B49 5LA

**Proposed:** Conversion of garage to habitable accommodation

**Decision:** The Parish Council recommended that the application be approved.

W/23/02086/HP Cladswell House, 44 Lower Cladswell Lane, Cookhill, B49 5JY

**Proposed:** 2 Storey Rear Extension together with the provision of 2 new windows in the existing house gables

**Decision:** The Parish Council recommended that the application be approved

W/23/02171/HP Greensleeves, Edgioake Lane, Astwood Bank, Redditch, B96 6BG

Proposed: Proposed front and side boundary walls, 1800mm high metal gates and hard parking

areas. **Decsion:** The Parish Council felt that they were not qualified to comment on the application due to the Grade II listing status, they have asked that the qualified officers make the relevant

recommendations.
