Community Legacy Grant

The next round of the Wychavon Community Legacy Grant opened on 8th January. The grant is aimed at innovative, ambitious projects that will have a significant and lasting impact on one or more of Wychavon's strategic goals - particularly health and wellbeing, supporting people most in need, tackling climate change, access to local transport and links between places or improving the natural environment.

While applications will only be accepted from parish and town councils, Community Legacy Grant funded projects may be led or delivered by a community group with the full support of the relevant parish or town council. All details are on the Wychavon website as of 9th January.

Cookhill Allotments / Parish Council Fields

- Plots & Tenants There are currently 3 vacant plots, if you are interested in taking on a
 plot please contact David Claydon on 01527 894317 to be shown around the site.
- The persistent heavy rain has meant that the site is very wet and some plots are covered
 with pools of water. The additional drainage works undertaken mean that the internal
 grass tracks have recovered more quickly, which is a significant improvement on previous
 winters.
- Tenants have been reminded to take advantage of any dry weather over the coming
 months to give their plots some attention by removing perennial weeds / grass and to dig
 or lightly turn over the soil and add some manure or mature compost.
- Any tenant who intends to give up their tenancy at the end of March has been asked to notify the Allotment Association as soon as possible so that any remedial work can be planned.

Trees Call to Action Project

Heart of England Forest are promoting an initiative for community orchard projects. The Trees Call to Action Project (TCAP), alongside Wychavon and the UK Shared Prosperity Fund, partnered with Heart of England Forest, are offering schools and community groups the opportunity to access trees to plant an orchard.

Footpaths

A water leak reported on the footpath from Edgioake Lane to Botany Bay may have been identified as a natural spring. The Public Rights of Way Team are investigating the issue and liaising with the landowner.
